

What products are currently available?

Liquid ProBiotic Food (PBF) for plants is sold as a concentrated liquid (NPK is approximately 22-1-22 on a dry basis); normally mixed with water to make a 20% PBF/80% water fertigation liquid. Liquid PBF is available through a “milk-man-style” delivery service to growers on Vashon Island, and limited points of sale and pop-up giveaways.

This concentrated liquid is also dried to produce a dry spreadable product called PBF Dry Blend No. 7 (NPK is approx. 10-7-1). Dry Blend No. 7 is currently sold on Amazon ([link](#)) and Vashon Fresh ([link](#)).



Our team is excited to give back to the community and serve gardeners everywhere as well as commercial island growers. Our bulk tanks are now full for the growing season and we

are mobilizing to feed the island food system, build community and boost yields, all together! We are learning together with low-tech and high-tech growers. We will provide services to fill bulk tanks according to the specifics of each grower. Some are keen on hand and/or backpack applications, while others want to explore drip system injection (fertigation). Boom sprayers have also been used to broadcast liquid PBF. For fruit trees, especially those in distress, watering bags could be a good solution.
